Situate at the Northeast corner of Park Avenue and Rowley street, in the city of Greenville, and more particularly described as follows: Beginning at a stake at the intersection of Park Avenue and street, and running thence with the Northern line of Park Avenue S. 77 E. 60 feet, more or less, to an iron Pin, thence N. 20-45 E. 172 feet, more or less, to an iron Pin; thence N. 77 W. 60 feet, more or less, to an iron Pin on the last side of Rowley street, thence along said street S. 20-45 W. 172 feet, more or less, to the beginning corner, being the same lot of land conveyed to me by Ella M.
