all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina. In subdivision known as Augusta Circle, designated as lot No. 97, according to plat of said property: Beginning at an iron pin on the southwesterly side of Paris Road, joint corner of lots Nos. 96 & 97, and running thence with the joint line of said lots S. 71-35 W. 164.5 feet to an iron pin, then joint corner of lots Nos. 86, 87, 96 and 97, thence with the joint line of lots Nos. 97 and 98 N. 71-35 W. 165 feet to an iron pin on Paris Road, thence with the eastern side of Paris Road, N. 16-30 E. 117.36 feet to the point of beginning. I, R. G. Baugh, do hereby trust my wife, to hold the legal title to the said lot of land, until such time as in her discretion it is advisable to sell and convey said lot of land, to sell the same, or to mortgage it and part of the proceeds of sale pay off the mortgage debt now existing upon said premises, any surplus over and above the debts, after paying taxes, insurance premiums, repairs, and necessary compensation to the said Alma L.
