I, J. H. Wilburn, do hereby bind myself, my heirs, executors and administrators to grant, sell and release,

TO JAS. E. POURIFAY, Receiver for the American Bank and Trust Co., a South Carolina Banking Corporation, with its principal place of business in Columbia, said State,

LOT NO. 5, being a portion of land situated in Greenville, said County aforesaid, and being known and designated as Lot No. 5, as shown on plat of the J. H. Wilburn property, said plat being of record in the office of the P.M.C. for Greenville County in Plat Book "Z", at page 203, beginning at the southeast corner of Lot No. C, running thence S. 45-33 E. 31 feet; thence S. 45-33 E. 100-6 feet; thence N. 47-48 E. 31 feet; thence S. 42-30 E. 150-6 feet; and lot has a frontage on the south side of West Washington Street, of twenty-two feet.

Also: All those lots of land, situated in the County and State aforesaid and fronting on Horsley Road, near the City of Greenville, and being known and designated as Lots No. 11, 12, 13, 14, 15 or above our plat of said property recorded in said P.M.C. Office in Plat Book "C" at page 121, and having such areas and bounds as are shown therein, the whole in the aggregate containing Twenty and 11/100 (20-11/100 A.) acres, more or less, being the same lots conveyed to the grantee herein by J. G. Heath by deed recorded in deed book 97, at page 228, office of said P.M.C.

Also: All that place, part of lot of land, situated, lying and being in Greenville County, said State, on the Horsley Bridge Road about two and one-half miles from Greenville County Court House and being a portion of lot No. 1-3 of West Highland, as shown on plat recorded in said P.M.C. Office in Plat Book "C", at page 267-268, and having the following areas and bounds: Beginning at a stake at the southeast corner of Horsley Bridge Road and Georgia Avenue, running thence with Horsley Bridge Road N. 71-00 E. approximately 58.5 feet to a stake at corner of lot conveyed to Jas. A. Russell and Jas. W. Lippard by J. H. Wilburn, good dated July 6th, 1922, recorded in deed book 82 at page 195; thence with Russell and Lippard's line, S. 11-00 E. 55 feet to a stake in line of lot of C. A. Hagan; thence with Hagan's line, S. 71-00 W. 37.4 feet, more or less to a stake on Georgia Avenue; thence with Georgia Avenue N. 9-10 W. 55 feet to the beginning point. Being the same property conveyed to me by J. H. Wilburn, by his deed dated December 21st, 1922, recorded in deed book 78, at page 239 and subject to the following right of way.

This deed of conveyance is subject to a right of way over and across the southern side of the lot herein conveyed, over a driveway nine feet in width, extending from Georgia Avenue to a lot of land sold by J. H. Wilburn to Jas. A. Russell, September 20th, 1922 as a means of ingress and egress from Georgia Avenue for the owner or owners of said lot sold to Jas. A. Russell by J. H. Wilburn. See deed from J. H. Wilburn to Jas. A. Russell recorded in deed book 78, at page 262.

See deed from E. Lamm, Master to grantee herein for former conveyance to grantee herein of the first described lot in this deed, recorded in deed book 94 at page 292. All of the above property is conveyed free from all liens and encumbrances.
