In the space aforesaid, the sum aforesaid is hereby acknowledged, have granted bargained sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release,

from the date May 12th, 1926,

at the place, part or lot of land in Section

Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina

Containing 7.6 acres, more or less, being all that remains of a tract of land originally containing 21.15 acres, more or less, conveyed by Amanda G. Austin to Lawrence Moore by her deed dated December 14, 1926, recorded in S. M. C. Office for said County in book 43, page 65. The said Lawrence Moore conveyed a tract of 4.1 acres to said L. Murray, his deed recorded in book 96, page 53, and thereafter, by deed dated April 1, 1926, and recorded in book 97, page 269, contained the remainder to Nellie G. Brown. Thereafter, by deed dated May 26, 1926, and recorded in book 114, page 189, Nellie Grace Brown conveyed 1.8 acres out of said tract to M. L. Ward, and it is the intention of this deed to convey the entire remainder of said tract, being 7.63 acres. For a more particular description of tract covered by this conveyance reference to the above mentioned deeds is hereby made. Said tract lies between the White Rose and Piedmont Roads, about six miles south of Greenville Courthouse, and fronting old Lenhardt Road.

Also all that tract of land in Barth Township, County and State aforesaid, on the south side of the White Rose Road and on the west side of the Negro Cemetery, and having the following corner and boundary points: Beginning at an iron pin on the corner of Mrs. Meyer's property in the road leading to Mrs. Sarah Muller's home place; thence N. 4 E. 858 feet to center of White Rose Road to an iron pin; thence N. 34-30 W. 1.96 feet to another pin; thence S. 20 W. 1.34 ft. to an iron pipe or pipe corner on other land of Lawrence Moore and George A. Clegg; thence N. 84-30 S. 458 feet to the beginning corner containing 7.7 acres more or less, being a portion of the same conveys to Nellie Grace Brown by Lawrence Moore, his deed dated April 1, 1926, recorded in S. M. C. book 97, page 269.

Williams her heirs and assigns forever.
