in the place whereof the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have granted bargained sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release,

all that piece or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina,

beginning at the corner of Main and Broad, and bounded  
 by, running to the corner between Main and Broad,  
 and the River, and a road running from the intersection  
 to the river, and thence over the next ridge, from  
 my said to number seven, the Southern Railway, in the  
 direction of Washington Street, and running the following  
 course and bounds, according to a plat made by Mr.  
 Furman B. Pinson, dated Oct. 1926.

Bounding on the west by a rail road, and running  
 northwardly about 100 feet and to an iron fence. Thence  
 running southwardly about 100 feet, and thence  
 eastwardly about 100 feet to the first turn  
 in the road, and my said road then being said  
 road in the same direction as my said road, then being said  
 road in the beginning of the business  
 of the town of Greenville, County said,  
 then running in a three-sided fence, which is
