all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville, Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina.

In the city of Greenville, on the North side of Elough Avenue, and known on the Plat of East Park, made by W. A. Adams in July, 1909, and recorded in Plat Book "A", at Page 383, as the Southern Portion of Lot No. 115 of Section 8, having the following metes and bounds: Beginning at an iron Pin on the right of way of the Charleston & Western Carolina Railroad track, which is fifty feet from the center of the track and on the north side of Elough Avenue, and running with Elough Avenue 35 feet to an iron Pin marking Lot No. 116; thence with line of lot No. 116 - 140 feet to an iron Pin; thence in a southeasterly direction parallel with Elough Avenue to a point where this line intersects the right-of-way of the Charleston & Western Carolina Railway Company; thence in a southwesterly direction to the beginning corner, being subject to a mortgage of \$400.00 given by R. M. Graham to Wm. H. Surine, dated March 16th, 1921, and recorded in volume 96, at Page 284.

also all that certain Piece, Parcel or lot of land situated lying and being in the state of South Carolina, and in City and County of Greenville, and being known as Lot No. 116 on Plat of East Park, which Plat is recorded in Plat Book "A", at Page 383, and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

Beginning at a stake on the northeast side of Elough Avenue 35 feet from the right-of-way of the W. & R. Ry., and running thence with line of lot No. 115, N. 35° E. 140 feet to a stake; thence N. 59° 45' W. 50 feet, more or less, to a stake; corner of lot No. 117; thence with line of said lot S. 35° W. 140 feet to a stake on Elough Avenue; thence with Elough Avenue 3.55 E. 50 feet to the beginning corner being subject to a mortgage of \$2000.00 given by R.
