All that certain piece, parcel or tract of land situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina but County of Greenville, in Oak Haven Township about seventeen miles from the City of Greenville, having the following metes and bounds according to a plat thereof made by C. J. Riddle, bearing date February 20, 1918, to wit: Beginning at a stone 340 m about ten or twelve feet, more or less east of the present line of the Augusta Road, said stone being on the line of the old, or abandoned bed of said Augusta Road, and running thence along said abandoned bed and long line of land belonging to S. V. Chandler N. 28 deg 40 min 34.899 chains to a stone 322 m, thence S. 763 deg 30 (crossing the present line of the Augusta Road) along line of a tract of land belonging to George W. Stone 21.10 chains to a stone 34.8 m, line of land belonging to C. O. Jordan; thence along line of last mentioned land S 31 deg 45 min E. 11.15 chains to a stone from on point corner of land belonging to Moton and long belonging to J. H. Riddle, thence along the Riddle line N. 96 deg E 26.82 chains to a stone 34.8 m, line of land crossed by the st. Stone to A. B.
