the Cedar Lane Road, about two and one-half miles west of  
the Greenville County Court House, and being known and  
designated as the Eastern half of Lot 8 on Plat of Cedar Lane  
made by J. N. Southern, and having the following  
metes and bounds, to-wit: Beginning at a point  
on the North side of Cedar Lane Road, corner of lot  
hereunto before recd by George M. Moore et al., to R. L. Harrison,  
which point is 524 feet from the corner of lots nos  
7 and 8, on above mentioned Plat, and running thence  
along line of Harrison lot N. 9 $\frac{1}{2}$  E. 210 feet to a post in
