the Subdivision of lots made by Will Bailey  
from the Association City Land and Improvement Company  
as shown by a plat made by Wm. A. Stedman, on  
May 24th, 1905 and recorded in Plat 50 at page  
108 in Deeds of the County of Greenville County and  
not less than at one hour from the south side of  
State Street 116 1/3 feet from the southeast corner of  
lot 45 and 160 1/2 feet east and runs thence S. 23° 4' E.  
15' 7" feet to an iron pin on line of Dr. John Marshall's  
land; thence north 16° 56' 1/2 E. 47' feet to an iron  
pin 102 1/2' of lot no. 6, thence with line 34' to lot no. 6
