the parties aforesaid, have agreed Bargained Sold and Released and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said W.D. Henderson, his heirs and assigns, all that lot or parcel of land, lying, being and situated on the branch waters of Puddie River, Fairview, State and County aforesaid, containing the remaining portion of the following described lot of land. Said balance containing about twelve acres, more or less, and having the following notes and bounds, to-wit: bounded by W.T. Jones, J.E. Jones, J.L. Garrett and T.M. Goldsmith; Commencing at center of branch, running thence N. 75° E. 6.76 chs. to a stone 3x; thence S. 3° E. 15.16 chs. to a stone 3x; thence S. 3° E. 9.41 chs. to a stone 3x; thence S. 73° E. 4.49 chs. to oak tree; thence S. 47° E. 1.50 chs. to center of creek; thence down said Creek to south of branch; thence up said branch to beginning corner, being the same lot or parcel of land conveyed to J.E. Thackston by J.W. Cox of Simpsonville, S.C., by deed dated the fourth day of January 1912 and deeded to J.B. Chandler by J.E. Thackston 4th, day of January 1916 and from J.B. Chandler to J.W. Cox, January 2nd, 1916. All the certain place, parcel and lot of land situated in Fairview Township, State and County aforesaid about one and one-half miles West of Simpsonville, being a part of tract of land conveyed to L.A. Crisp by J.W. Cox, adjoining lands of L.A. Crisp and the above described property and having the following notes and bounds, to-wit:- Beginning on a red oak on the road; thence N. 73° E. 6.74 chs. to a stone 3x; thence N. 54° E. 7.20 chs. to the road; N. 14-3/4 E. 2.84 chs. to the beginning corner, containing ninety-seven hundredths of an acre, more or less, being the same property conveyed to J.E. Thackston by deed of L.A. Crisp of date the 30th, day of September 1913, all the above described land, or hereinafter described, which was deeded to R.C. Holcombe by L.A. Crisp January 2nd, 1918 and having the following notes and bounds, to-wit: Beginning at an iron pin on the West side of branch and running thence N. 75° E. 6.48 chs. to a stone; thence N. 54° E. 7.20 to an iron pin in Neely Ferry Road; thence S. 14-3/4 E. 2.84 to small red oak; thence N. 29-3/4 E. 15.86 to a stone; thence N. 83-1/4 E. 2.40 to a stone, J.E. Jones line; thence S. 4-3/4 E. 6.50 to an iron pin; thence N. 68-1/4 E. 12.00 chs. to an iron pin on branch; thence up the meanderings of said branch 23.65 to the beginning corner. Said lands being a portion of land deeded to L.A. Crisp by J.B. Chandler, Jan. 2nd, 1916 and from L.A. Crisp to R.G. Holcomb, January 2nd, 1918.
