KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That,

W. J. Youngman

In the State aforesaid,  
in consideration of the sum of  
One Thousand One Hundred and Ten Dollars,  
to W. J. Youngman,  
at and before the sealing of these presents by W. J. Youngman,  
in hand paid

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said  
W. J. Youngman, that certain tract of land  
situate in the City of Greenville, in  
the County of Greenville, known as lot  
31, in the Division of the said tract of land property,  
located in the office for Greenville County  
Court, and having the following tract and bounds, to wit:  
a stake at the corner of Muller Street and running  
across Muller Street 60 feet, to a stake at the  
corner of Muller Street and lot 165 feet to  
the "M" line, then along said line 165 feet to  
a stake on said line 60 feet to a stake on said Muller  
Street, thence along said Muller Street 165 feet to the  
beginning.  
The grantor has, acceptance of this deed, conveanted  
that he will not interfere on said lot any surface  
rights he may have, but only specific rights as other  
rights he may have, may be provided by the grantee  
and the property lot of land conveyed to the  
grantee herein by G. E. Gossage by Deed dated  
February 10th, 1925 and recorded in the R. R. C.  
Book 5, Greenville County in Vol. 107, page 265.  
Also, the grantor has other certain lots or tracts  
of land in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina,  
known as lot 31, block 6 of Land Office, G. E. Gossage,  
and the same for a tract located in G. E. Gossage,  
successor, having a survey of W. M. Schell, known  
as "The Green" said tract being recorded in the  
Land Office for Greenville County in Plat Book "F"  
page 140, said lot having a frontage each of 60  
feet on the Northeast side of King Street and each  
feet in depth of 150 feet, same being and being the  
same lot conveyed to the grantee by G. E. Gossage  
by Deed dated February 10th, 1925 and recorded in the  
R. R. C. Office for Greenville County in Vol. 106, page  
236.  
Taxes for the year 1925 and insurance to be  
prorated.

heirs, executors and administrators, to warrant and forever defend, all and singular, the said premises unto the said G. A. Neal, his  
heirs and assigns, against W. J. Youngman and Mrs. E. McElaine, and  
heirs, and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming, or to claim the same, or any part thereof.
