Rosa H. Marchbanks the house and lands
situate in Greenville County, South Carolina, and being
a tract of land of a full road known as lot
15 in the town of Greenville, and designated as lot
15 in the plan by S. C. Plan, June 1911 of what is
now known as the subdivision at the Goldsmith and Agnew
land tract, recorded in plat book A at
page 52, in one acre 46 1/2 sq. ft. for Greenville County,
and said tract is bounded by the following lines and boundaries:

beginning at the west point corner of lot #6
and #7 road, running S. 45° 15' E. 1225 feet to an iron
gate in a road branch, said branch being the
same distance from tract and land of J. E. Meany,
house corner of said branch 77 1/2 feet to and
from said corner as lot #7, thence along line of lot #7,
1225 feet to gate in the line between lots #7 and
#8, thence along line of lot #8 to iron
gate in road, above referred to, thence along said road
1/2 foot to the beginning corner, containing 19.4 acres,
and so less according to said plat and passing the
said tract of land known as the by Arthur S. Agnew,

Bates, bearing date of April 21, 1924, with interest at
the seven per cent per annum; said grantee agrees
to assume and pay all principal and interest that
may be due thereon as of this date.
