the receipt whereof I hereby acknowledge, have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said

H. V. Sheppard all that piece, parcel or lot of land, situate
and lying in Greenville County and State aforesaid, near
the town of Greenville on the North side of the New Cut
Branching from River having the following metes and
bounds, to wit:

Bounding, to the North in the center of said Road and
the same extends Southwesterly about 700 feet, North 70° East
and then turns to the right about 66° 42' East 99° 5' West
thence South 55° 55' East 264 feet to a poplar
tree 4 feet 6' East 4' 5' cut to a pine stump, thence
South 55° 55' cut to a cedar tree, South
55° 55' cut to a cedar in the center of the said
Highway between two Roads, thence at the point of intersection
of the said Highway and Beaufortburg Road, thence with the new
Highway South 35° 55' W. 483.3 feet to a
stile in the center of said road, thence stile with
Highway South 75° 5' West, 81.7 feet to the beginning
