G. Huff, S. 30 E. 2.44 to stake; thence S. 16.30 E. 6.68 to stake; thence S. 50.30 E. 3.50 to stake; thence S. 42 E. 8.65 to stone; joint corner of lands of J. J. Richardson and J. M.
