A. G. New his heirs and assigns.
All that certain piece, parcel or tract of land
situate, lying and being in Glassy Mountain
Township in the County of Greenville
State of South Carolina, and containing one
hundred eighty-six acres (86) more or less, lying
on the top of Hogback Mountain, and known
as the Ramsey Butler tract and more fully
described as follows, situate, lying and being
in Glassy Mountain Township in County and
state of above said, containing One Hundred
eighty-six (86) acres, more or less, lying on top of
Hogback Mountain, and known as the Ramsey
Butler tract, being near the lands recently
sold by the heirs of the late L. M. Wilder
to A. E. Johnson, and near lands of Joshua
Kendray, et al. having the following lines,
