The receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said Thomas Somay, his heirs and assigns, forever: Two lots of land in the city of Greenville, County of Greenville, state of South Carolina, and the same are described as follows: First: Lot No. 5 according to a plan recorded in Plan Book "A" page 1493, R. M. C. office for Greenville County and conveyed to me by T. M. 1912 A. D. date dated March 24th, 1920, recorded in said R. M. C. office for Greenville County in Plan Book 55, page 316, said lot has a frontage of 42.5 feet on Trotter street with a depth of 110 feet. Second: Beginning 135 feet west of Anderson St. or street, thence N. 47 1/2 W. 100 feet to a twenty (20) foot alley; thence along said alley S. 44 W. 50 feet; thence S. 46 E. 100 feet, thence N. 46 1/2 E. 50 feet to the beginning corner; said land having been conveyed to me by W. R. Sevill, dated recorded Deed Book 10, page 157, said R. M. C. office for Greenville County.

The grantee assumes most mortgage executed by me to the Carolina Loan & Trust Company which amounts to Two thousand and one dollar to this date.
