(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said M. M. Arnold, all that piece, parcel or lot of land having the following metes and bounds, to-wit: - Beginning at a stake in the south side of Ebaugh Avenue at the corner of lot now so farmed by C. W. McRae, and running thence with the main line in a southwesterly direction 140 feet to a stake; thence parallel with Ebaugh Avenue S. 55 E. 75 feet to the northerly corner, embracing the southern portion of lot no. 22 as recorded on a plat made by W. A. Adams, July 1904, recorded in R. M. C. office for Greenville County in plat Book "A", page 382 and being the same lot conveyed to Mrs. O. Thomas by J. C. Parker by deed dated July 19th, 1922, and recorded in Volume 75, page 221, R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, and being the same lot conveyed to me by George C. Thomas by deed dated January 29th, 1924, to be recorded.

The above described land is the same conveyed to me by on the day of 1925, deed recorded in office of Register of Deeds Conveyance for Greenville County, in Book 98, Page 73, TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular, the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining.
