The receipt whereof I hereby acknowledge, have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said  
Mrs. Annie Jenkins Coates, a life interest for her end at her death to her children: All  
that certain piece, parcel or tract of land situate, lying and being in the County of  
Greenville, State of South Carolina, in Oaklawn Township, and being more fully described  
as follows:  
Beginning at an iron pin by road and running thence along said road S. 57-10 E. 4-98  
to bend in road; thence continuing along said road S. 32-50 E. 9-70 to creek where the  
same crosses said road; thence S. 35-30 E. 14-57 to stone; thence N. 62-40 W. 17-12  
to stone; thence S. 35-30 E. 6-27 to the beginning corner, and containing 18 acres,  
more or less.  
Also all that certain piece, parcel and tract of land situate, lying and being in the  
County and State aforesaid in Oaklawn Township and adjoining the tract of land hereinabove  
described, said tract being more particularly described as follows:  
Beginning at a stone in line of S. 1. Berry property and running thence N. 52-40 W. 10-48  
to a stone; thence N. 4-3/4 E. 11-26 to an iron pin; thence S. 41 E. 4-45 to a stake;
