Hill all that certain lot or parcel of land situate in the State of South Carolina, Greenville County, known as tract #70, lot plat #2 of the Parker Land Company made by J. S. Kiddie April 1914, situated at the intersection of the Lipscomb and Parker Roads, and bounded by tracts #s 73, 74, 72, 71, 68 and 69, beginning at a stake in the center of the Parker Road at the point of its junction with the New Poor House Road, running with the line of tract #74 and 73 to a stake, then bearing to tract #74 and 73 to a fence, with the line of tract #73 N. 88 1/4 W. 669 ft. to a stake in the line of tract #69, and in the center of Lipscomb Road, thence with the center of said road, S. 30 1/2 E. 520 ft.
