Mrs. Amy Rhew, her heirs and assigns forever: All that certain 1/2 Acre Parcel or lot of land situated, lying and being in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, about 1/2 mile, Northwest of the Corporate limits of the City of Greenville, known and designated as lot # 5, 50 Acre of lands of the Estate of George W. Rhew, deceased, made by G. M. Furman, Engineer, February 14th, 1922, and recorded in Plat Book 5, Page 57 of the Public Office for Greenville County, said lot having the following sides and bounds according to said Plat: Beginning at a stake on the Northwest side of Patterson Street at corner of lot # 4 (which stake is 191.2 feet from the iron pin on Hampton Avenue corner of lot # 3) and running thence with line of lot # 4, N. 44-54 W. 136.6 feet to an iron pin in Park Street; thence with Park Street N. 46 E. 67.3 feet to stake corner of lot # 6; thence S. 44 E. 142 feet to iron pin on Patterson Street; thence with Patterson Street S. 56 3/4 W. 66.2 feet to the beginning corner.

This conveyance is made on condition that no part of the property above described shall ever be sold, leased or otherwise disposed of to any person of African Descent. As a part of the consideration herein the grantee assumes the payment of the balance due on a mortgage created by me to the American Building and Loan Association of Greenville, S. C.

Sweet on the 12th day of June 1922, deed recorded in office of Register of Meigs Conveyance for Greenville County, in Book 76 Page 157 TOGETHER with, all and singular, the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular, the said premises before mentioned unto the said Mrs. Amy Rhew, her heirs, and assigns, forever.
