Lucy P. Cass, her heirs, and assigns forever, all that certain piece or parcel, lot or tract of land, lying, situate and being in the City of Greenville, Ward One in State and County aforesaid, and bounded as follows: to-wit: Beginning at corner of lot 4904, or formerly owned by Robert South, side of West Park Street, and running thence North 100 feet to a fence, thence East 200 feet to a fence, thence South 100 feet to an iron pin, thence West 100 feet to a point on south side of West Park Street, thence East 35.00 feet to the beginning point of lot 4904, or formerly owned by W. E. Payne, as shown on plat dated May 1, 1925, not yet recorded. In a part consideration for this conveyance the grantee herein assumes and agrees to pay according to the terms thereof two notes secured by mortgages on the within premises as follows: Note dated October 27, 1923, together with mortgage same date given by Mary Jean Anderson to M.
