(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said

Elsie Hall Haynesworth all that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate lying and being on the West side of Towne Street in Ward One of the city of Greenville, County and State aforesaid, known being known as lot number 9 on plat known as Towne Street Property made by Wm. J. Steele, C. E. October 1909, and recorded in the R. M. C. office for Greenville County in that book of Cleveland and Williams and having according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to wit:

beginning at a stake at corner of lots No. 6, and, running thence along the line of lot No. 6 N. 76 W. 223 feet and four inches to an iron pin on a 17 foot alley, thence with the line of said alley N. 14 E. 60 feet and 5 inches to an iron pin joint corner of lot N. 8, thence with line of lot N. 8 S. 87 1/2 E. 259 feet and 8 inches to an iron pin on Towne Street S. 21 1/2 W. 61 feet to the beginning corner being the same lot of land conveyed to me by Elpidio Colon Trustee by deed dated February 7th 1919, and recorded in R. M. C. office in lot 5, page 265.
