(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said

J. T. Smith and M. C. Davenport

I, J. T. Smith, aforesaid, do hereby convey to M. C. Davenport, my wife, all that certain parcel or lot of land, with the improvements thereon, situate and being in Chick Springs Township, said County and State, beyond the intersection of the limits of the City of Greenville, fronting on the North Carolina National Highway, also known as State Highway 18, measuring therein seventy feet, and running southerly in parallel lines to a depth of about one hundred and seventy feet, and being upon an easement of 48 on subdivision of property of R. H. Bearden and J. T. Smith as per plan recorded in Plat book 1, page 236, except a strip on the western side thereof fronting eleven feet on said Highway and running southerly to a point where it crosses the eastern line of said lot #8, herefore to me by Eva H. and Claude J. Andrews and subtracting at a strip beginning at the crossing of the lines above mentioned and southerly extending to the lot below described and measuring eighteen feet which was heretofore conveyed by me to Eva H. and Claude J. Andrews, and adding on the eastern line of lot #8 a strip measuring on the south side of the lot below described a distance of eighteen feet and extending northerly until it crosses the eastern line of said lot #8; and subtracting a strip beginning at the said crossing of lines above mentioned on the eastern side of lot #8 and extending northerly to the said Highway in hereinbefore measured eleven feet, the last addition and subtraction being more fully shown by exchange of deeds between myself and J. T. Jones, all as shown by a recent plat (hereby by H. J. Brockman).

I also that other lot of land adjoining the one above described and measuring therein one hundred and thirty feet, and extending southerly in almost parallel lines but measuring on its western line one hundred and eight feet, and on its eastern line one hundred and fifty one and six-tenths feet, the said dimensions taken out less, and being the same lot conveyed to me by J. T. Smith by deed recorded in book 105, page 595.

The above described land is the same conveyed to me by J. T. Smith and M. C. Davenport, on the day of May 1927, deed recorded in office of Register of Deeds Conveyance for Greenville County, in Book 102, Page 192, together with all and singular, the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining, TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular, the said premises before mentioned unto the said J. T. Smith and M. C. Davenport, heirs, heirs, and assigns, forever,
