Newby's line and running N. 58° E. 30' Chains to an Iron Pin Fate Sammons corner; thence S. 39° E. 6. 632 Chains to an Iron Pin at the road leading from the Jones Gap road to Hellams Creek; thence S. 58° W. 1.02 Chains to an iron Pin; thence S. 31° E. 21 links to an Iron Pin on the road; thence S. 42 1/2 W. 3.25 Chains to a corner in W.
