Mrs. Bertha Brockman, subject to the reservation of the following described land to wit: all that certain piece, parcel, and tract of land situate in and being in Fair Mountain Township, County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, and being known and de- scribed in Deed No. 3 according to a survey and indorsement of the said Mrs. McNabb's land made by her on October 30, 1924, and having the following boundaries and course and distances as shown by said plat to wit: Beginning at an iron pin at the junction of Pickens Road in line of Deed No. 1 and running thence along the line of Deed No. 1 to a 4 1/2 iron on a branch; thence along the line of said branch 400 to stone 12m; thence thence along the boundary of said branch as the line 14.27 to a stone in place of 12.0; thence 77 to stone for road and in line of Deed No. 1 thence along the road to the line and along the line of Deed No. 1 to a iron pin at the intersection of this road and the Greenville and Pickens road; thence along the east boundary of said road as the line 19.30 to the beginning corner and containing 4 3/4 acres, more or less."
