and assumption of below described mortgage

to it in hand duly paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents by the grantee, hereinafter named (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto

Gladys H. Steedly

All that parcel, piece or lot of land with the buildings and improvements thereon, situate, lying and being just outside the corporate limits of the City of Greenville, County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, known and designated as Lot No 26 of Block 2, in the subdivision of Northgate Heights, the plat recorded in the R.M.C.'s Office for Greenville County in Plat Book "I", pages 135-136, and having according to said plat the following metes and bounds, courses and distances, to wit:

Beginning at an iron pin on the Northeast side of Avondale Drive, which iron pin is 209.2 feet West of the intersection of North Main Street and Avondale Drive, and running thence along the West side of a 12-foot alley, 16' 15" E., 128 feet to an iron pin on the rear corner of Lots Nos. 25 and 26, thence with the front line of said lots, 27' 55" S., 128.1 feet to an iron pin on the East side of Avondale Drive, thence along the said Avondale Drive in a curved line turning to the Southeast, 133.2 feet to the beginning.

Rescind the same lot of land conveyed to the South Carolina Security Company by John C. Mission by deed dated August 22, 1925 and recorded in said office of Deeds Vol. 146 page 151.

The grantee by accepting this deed assumes and agrees to pay as a mortgage executed by John C. Mission to the South Carolina Security Company, which has been assigned to the Metropolitan Life Insurance Company dated June 23, 1931 and recorded in said office for Mortgage Vol. 230, at page 50, upon which there is now due the sum of Four Thousand Sixty three & 75/100 (\$4,073.75) Dollars.
