EXECUTIVE DEPARTMENT. WHEREAS, H. D. Workman and L. J. Simpson Jr both of Greenville, S.C.

did on the 10th day of June, 1929, file with the Secretary of State a written Declaration signed by themselves, setting forth: FIRST: That their names and residences are as above given. SECOND: That the name of the proposed Corporation is Genesee Investment Corporation. THIRD: That the principal place of business is Greenville, S.C.
