 West Greenville, County and State aforesaid, more
 particularly described as follows:
 Lot #1: Beginning at a stake corner of P. S. H.
 Major's property running thence with said
 property N.W. 570-506. 2.8 to an iron pin; thence
 E. 17.7' to an iron pin; thence S. 25-11' E. 5'-
 to an iron pin on Hoodside Avenue; thence
 with Hoodside Avenue N. 32-29' E. 66.6' to the begin-
 ning corner being part of the property conveyed
 to me by G.C. Stover by Deed dated February 27,
 1918, recorded in office of F.M.C. for Greenville
 County in Vol. 30, page 256; and April 9, 1919,
 recorded in said office in Vol. 44, page 479,
 respectively.
