Kierath and his heirs and assigns forever the following described real estate, to-wit: certain piece, parcel or tract of land, situate, lying and being in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, on the Mountain road about three miles from the City of Greenville near Camp River, being a portion of tract surveyed by Benjamin King, deceased and designated as tract no. 1 on plot filed in the Probate Court for Greenville County, said State, in the case Benjamin J. King, executor vs. Nathaniel Grayson, et al. made by W. H. Bailey on March 23, 1920, with the following lines, courses and distances to-wit: Beginning at an iron pin and stone and running thence N. 32 E. 420 feet to an iron pin, in Douglas line thence S. 85 E. 690 feet to a stone, thence line running through the center of Spring, thence N. 87 E. 400 feet to an iron pin in the center of the road, thence N. 87 E. 79 feet to a stone, Amanda Young's corner, thence up the branch corner thence S. 89 W. 1.177 feet to the beginning corner, containing 9.64 acres more or less
