NOW, therefore, Know all Men by these Presents, That I, E. Inman, Master in and for the County of Greenville, aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of Eleven hundred fifty (\$1150.00), Dollars, to me paid by the said W. S. Powell,

the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, HAVE GRANTED, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents DO GRANT, bargain, sell and release unto the said

W. S. Powell, his heirs and assigns forever, an undivided one-half interest in and to the following described real estate: "all that certain tract of land situate in the Township of Greenville, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, just west of the Southern Railway, beginning at a stake on the North side of Old West Street and running thence S. 31° 30' E. 71 feet to a stake on the right of way of the Southern Railway; thence N. 3° 30' W. 145.5 feet parallel with said right of way to a stake; thence N. 48 W. 34 feet to a stake; thence S. 33° 36' W. 161 feet to a stake on Old West Street; thence along said street S. 49° 30' E. 99 feet to the beginning point. The deed to this lot is recorded in vol. 75, Page 22, R. M. G. office for Greenville County, and in H. Goodlett on the one half interest therein. Also; "all that certain Piece, Parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in the city and county of Greenville and being a portion of Boyce's Addition and having the following metes and bounds, according to Plat in R. 
