for the sum of One Thousand Fifty (\$150.00) Dollars, being at that price the highest bidder therefor.

NOW, therefore, Know all Men by these Presents, That I, Greenville Master in and for the County of Greenville, aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of One Thousand Fifty (\$150.00) Dollars, to me paid by the said Jessie L. Dayley

the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, HAVE GRANTED, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents DO GRANT, bargain, sell and release unto the said

Jessie L. Dayley and her heirs and assigns forever, the following described real estate, all that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in the City of Greenville, State and County aforesaid, in Ward Five, fronting on Lincoln Street, bid corner, the corner of land now or formerly owned by Sherman on 60 feet; thence N. 43 E. 140 feet to a stake on Sowell Avenue, thence with said line N. 70 1/2 E. 140 feet to a stake; thence with Sherman's line S. 12 1/2 W. 140 feet to the beginning corner; also; all that piece of land situate, lying and being in the City of Greenville, County of Greenville, State aforesaid, and adjoining the lot above described and having the following number and boundaries, to wit; Beginning at a stake on Lincoln Street on corner of lot formerly owned by Nichols Street; thence with said street N. 78 1/2 W. 140 feet to stake; thence S. 11 1/2 W. 139 feet to stake on Lincoln Street to thence easterly with Lincoln Street 40 feet to the beginning corner.
