In the State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of... Five (\$ 12.00)to me Charlotte J. Bennett in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold, and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said Charlotte J. Bennett, all my right, title and interest, in and to the following described real estate, the same being a one-half interest, inherited from my father, the late George M. Bennett:  
 All those certain pieces, parcels and lots of land, situate, lying and being in and near Greenville County and State of Georgia, known as lot no. 22, 23 and 24, and two-thirds of lot no. 22, (or a depth of 46 feet by the frontage of 69 feet of lot no. 22 on Norwood Street) out plot known as lot no. 1, of Pendaron Division, and being more particularly described as follows:  
 Beginning at a point of the west side of Norwood Street, 230 ft. from the intersection of Norwood and Pendleton Streets, and running thence along the line of Norwood Street, N. 25-45-0. 240 ft. to the corner of lot no. 23, the intersection of Norwood and Pendleton Streets; and running thence with the south side of Pendleton Street, N. 79-40-21. 10 ft. to a point, joint corner of lots nos. 24 and 25, thence along the line of lot no. 20-22-46-21. 26 ft. to a point, on lot no. 22, 11.0 ft. from the point of Norwood Street; thence along the line of lot no. 22, S. 70-41-0. to the point of beginning.
