KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS That I, H. R. Bright of the County
of Greenville, in consideration of the love and affection I hold for
my sisters hereinafter mentioned, to wit, Lizzie C. Bright, Ella F. Bright and Patry O. Bright,
do hereby give and grant unto them, my said sisters, the sum of One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by Lizzie C. Bright
and Ella F. Bright and Patry O. Bright.

(The receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold, and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said
Lizzie C. Bright and Ella F. Bright and Patry O. Bright
trustees and assigns forever, all my interest whatever
in, and to, all the following described lots, or parcels
of land, all in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina,
bearing and being in the State and County
aforesaid, the said corner, and having the following
width and length, to wit: Beginning at a point at the
intersection of Fairview Ave. and North Main Street,
thence easterly along Marshall St. 40 feet, running thence S. 72° 30' W.
60 feet, thence S. 82° 30' E. 60 feet, thence N. 72° 30' E. 60 feet
to said Fairview Ave.; thence with Fairview Ave. N. 82° 30' W.
150 feet to the beginning corner, and being the same tract
as conveyed by J. B. Merden Hall to J. A. Stone.
Also all that other (piece) parcel of land lying
and bounded, 10-1/2 feet; beginning at a point on Fairview
Ave. corner of the above described lot, and running
thence S. 72° 30' W. 80 feet; thence S. 82° 30' E. 64 feet; thence
N. 72° 30' E. 80 feet to said Fairview Ave., thence with
Fairview Ave. N. 82° 30' W. 64 feet, to the beginning
corner, being the same lot of land conveyed to

heirs and assigns, forever, and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same, or any part thereof.
