F. McElveen, J. W. Fowler, Chas. McAlister and others; and, being same located of which the late C. P. Howard, of Laurens County, State aforesaid, died seized, and possessed, and which descended to his widow, the aforesaid Lydia Howard, and his two infants, the defendants above named, as Nellie Howard, and J. Posey Howard?"

TOGETHER with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said Premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining, TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular, the said premises before mentioned, unto the said W. T. Thackston,

his heirs and assigns, forever.

AND we ourselves (successors and) do hereby bind heirs, executors and administrators, to warrant and forever defend, all and singular, the said premises unto the said W. T. Thackston.

his heirs and assigns, against us and

our heirs, and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same, or any part thereof, in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and Twenty six, day of October,
Fifty first, year of the Sovereignty and Independence of the United States of America.
