(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold, and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said

H. H. McIver, as Trustee

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate in the City of Greenville, County and State aforesaid, at the north east corner of McG. Daniel Avenue and McIver Street, and having, according to the plat of Dalton & Neves, Engineers, the following rights and bounds, to-wit:

Beginning at an iron pipe, the northeast corner of McG. Daniel Avenue and McIver Street, and running thence along McG. Daniel Avenue, N. 3-00 E. 183 feet to an iron pipe; thence S 85-00 E. 330 feet to an iron pin in line of Belmont Avenue; thence along Belmont Avenue, S. 3-00 W. 178.8 feet to an iron pin, the Northwest corner of Belmont Avenue and McIver Street; thence with McIver Street, N. 85-40 W. 329.8 feet to an iron pipe, the point of beginning being the same two lots which were set out separately in the deed by me to H. H. McIver, as Trustee, dated Aug. 29, 1928, and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, in Volume 143, at Page 70.

TOGETHER with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said Premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining, TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular, the said premises before mentioned, unto the said H. H. McIver, as Trustee, his successors

upon the following trusts, nevertheless, to-wit: to hold the legal title to said premises and to, at his discretion, convey the same as a whole or in parcels, making such terms with the purchaser as he may deem advisable (2) with full power in said Trustee to borrow money upon said premises upon such terms as he may deem advisable, and to secure the repayment thereof by executing a mortgage over said premises, (3) to collect the rents and profits and to pay from day to day, taxes, repairs, repay borrowed money, interest on money lent, the necessary expenses of managing and after expenses and to pay the balance, if any, remaining over to Bessie St. Mclver.
