the line of Mrs. Mamie Moon and J.
W. Moon 81.08 chains to center of Augusta
Road; thence up center of said road as
a line N 15° 31' E 5.45 ft stake; thence
N 74° 30' W 2.53 to stake on line of Mrs.

which either you may operate.
