M. C. Job, Greenville County in Plat Book "A" at page 70, and more particularly described as follows: Beginning at a pin on Langdon Street, and running thence with Langdon Street N. 1° 34' 62.5 feet to a stake on Langdon Street and on line of Brandon property; thence N. 84° 30' W. 80.2 feet to a stake; thence S. 10° E. 72 feet to a stake; thence S. 89° 30' E. 79 feet to the beginning corner.
