Stone, in trust, under the said deed for terms of trust, and thereafter B. R. Stone, as Trustee, subsequently conveyed all of said property to Harriet M. Stone, by deed dated June 9, 1932, recorded in Book of Deeds "114" at Page 534, said deed not referring to the terms of the trust under which Harriet M. Stone was to hold the same, nor containing any consent or ratification upon the beneficiary, E. E. Stone. Now, in order to remove any doubt as to the validity of said deed and as to the terms of the trust (of Harriet M. Stone)

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That B. R. Stone, as Trustee for E. E. Stone, and E. E. Stone in the State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of One Dollar (\$1.00) and premises

to one in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by Harriet M. Stone as Trustee for E. E. Stone

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold, and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said Harriet M. Stone, as Trustee for E. E. Stone, her heirs

and assigns, all of the real estate located in Greenville County, State of South Carolina, conveyed to B. R. Stone as Trustee for E. E. Stone, by deed dated February 2, 1932, recorded in Book of Deeds "161" at Page 384, and conveyed by B. R. Stone as Trustee for E. E. Stone, to Harriet M. Stone, by deed dated June 9, 1932, recorded in Book of Deeds "114" at page 534, excepting, however, any property heretofore conveyed by these Trustees, upon the following uses and trusts:
1. In trust, to hold the legal title to said property, to rent, sell, mortgage, exchange and by any other method dispose of any or all of said property, as well as other property subsequently acquired hereunto by said Trustee; to execute and deliver good and sufficient deeds and other instruments conveying or transferring title to purchasers in fee simple, with full power in said Trustee in her discretion to borrow money as often as she may deem advisable for the purpose of paying taxes or liens upon said property or of keeping same insured or repaired and of paying any of her debts, with power to receive such money borrowed by executing mortgages or mortgages over the property herein conveyed, or thereafter acquired as Trustee, without liability personally for any such debts incurred.
2. I authorize my Trustee to pay out of the sale of said property, taxes, insurance, repairs and all other and essential charges on said property, and the balance, if any, to be paid to me or my executor, or administrators.)

TOGETHER with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said Premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining, TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular, the said premises before mentioned, unto the said Harriet M. Stone as Trustee for E. E. Stone, her successors

heirs and assigns, forever.

AND we do hereby bind

ourselves and our heirs, executors and administrators, to warrant and forever defend, all and singular, the said premises unto the said Harriet M. Stone as Trustee for E. E. Stone, and her successors

heirs and assigns, against

ourselves and

our heirs, and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same, or any part thereof.
