(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold, and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said Mrs. Lyda Ward, my and all of my right, title, interest in and to or in any way concerning, all that certain piece, parcel and lot of land in State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, Chick Spring Township, being a portion of subdivision of E. M. Shabaston near Paris Station, and described in plat of subdivision made by R. E. Dalton and recorded in Plat Book F, page 208, and having the following metes and bounds:

Beginning at a stake on National Highway corner of Lots 40 and 41, and running thence N. 66°16' E. 30 feet to a stake corner of lots 41 and 42; thence in line of lots 41 and 42 N. 27°03' 26. 79. 6' to a stake corner of lots 41 and 42; th.
