All that certain piece, parcel and lot of land situate lying and being in Rock Springs Township, State and County aforesaid, on the south side of the National Highway, formerly described as Highway No 8, but now known as Federal Highway No 29, and bounded by lands now or formerly owned by J. B. Brannon, Nannie Coates, John L. Pittman, and having the following metes and bounds, to wit:

Beginning at an iron pin on the south end of this lot, at Mrs. Nannie Coates line, and thence N 21 $\frac{1}{4}$  W. Five and twenty four one-hundredths (5.24) chains to a point in the center of the said paved highway, now no 29, thence with the said highway, N. 36 $\frac{1}{2}$  E. one and ninety-one (1.91) chains to a point in the center of the highway; thence S. 21 $\frac{1}{4}$  E. Five and twenty-four one-hundredths (5.24) chains to a point in Nannie Coates line; thence S. 67 $\frac{1}{4}$  W.
