(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold, and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said Lizzie Turners, her heirs and assigns forever, all of our undivided rights, titles and interests of, in and to the following described tract of land, lying and being in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, on the water of Beaver Dam Creek, water of Enore River in Battle Township, and having the following metes and bounds: Beginning at a ironrod $3\frac{1}{2}$ meal a small road, thence S. 73° E. 10.50 chains to stone near a branch; thence up and with the meanderings of branch to the head thereof; thence N. 82° E. 3.75 chains to a road above mentioned; thence along said road S. 61° 24' 12.40 chains to a stone; thence S. 33° 45' W. 16.75 chains to the beginning corner, containing Twenty (20) acres, more or less, and adjoining lands more or less formerly belonging to Mrs. Garrison Frank Ligon, and others, and being the same tract of land conveyed to W. S. Turner by Fannie A. Clark by deed dated Nov. 15, 1890 and recorded in Vol 27 at page 213 in R. M. C. Office for Greenville County.
