All that lot of land, with all improvements and trade fixtures thereon, situate in Ward One of the City of Greenville, County and State aforesaid, on the west side of North Main Street, and being designated as Lot 14 upon a plat of the property of Mrs. Frances Montgomery, recorded in Plat Book 5, page 225; and being, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

Beginning at an iron pin on the west side of North Main Street, joint corner of Lots Nos 1 and 2, as shown on said plat, which point is 83 feet south of the southwest corner of the intersection of North Main and Elford Streets and running thence along the joint line of said lots N. 61.55 W. 100 feet to an iron pin on the east side of an eight foot alley; thence along the eastern side of said alley, S. 14.54 W. 20 feet to another pin in the line of Browning property; thence S. 61.55 E. 100 feet to another iron pin on the east side of an eight foot alley, S. 14.54 W. 20 feet to another pin in the line of Browning property; thence S. 61.55 E. 100 feet to an iron pin on the west side of North Main Street; thence with the west side of North Main Street N. 14.54 E. 20 feet to the point of beginning.
