Morris Brothers.

All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, in the City of Greenville, more particularly described as follows

beginning at a point on the east side of S. Main Street in the center of 17" brick wall which point is 55 ft. from the corner of S. Main Street and S. McBee Avenue and running west as a line S. 70-01 E. 120 ft. 6 ins. to a point in center of 17" brick wall where a 18" brick wall adjoins the same; thence with center of 12 in. brick wall N. 20-39 E. 66 ft. 7 ins. to a point on the S. side of S. McBee Ave. in the center of 12" brick wall, which point is 121 ft. 4 in. from the S. E. corner of Main Street and S. McBee Ave. and 231 ft. 3 ins. from the S. E. corner of S. McBee Ave. and Fall Street; and running thence from said point with S. side of S. McBee Avenue S. 70-20 E. 231 ft. to an iron pin at S. E. corner of S.
