All that certain lot and tract of land situate, lying and being in the County and State aforesaid in what is known as Jefferson Heights, located on First Ave., and known and designated as lots #s 21 and 24 on plat recorded in R. M. Co. Office for said County, plat Book 16, page 24 (reference to which is erased), lot 21, being bounded by lots 20, 22 and 46; and lot 24 being bounded by lots 23, 25 and 49. Each of said lots has a frontage on said First Ave of 25.5 feet and a depth of 87.5 feet. Said lots being in Block "A" of said plat.

Also, all my undivided one-half interest in and to all that other certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in the County and State aforesaid. Beginning at corner of lot #3, running thence N. 76.36 E. 210 feet to corner of lot #5; thence along lot #5 S. 13.30 E. 12.60 feet to point corner lot #6; thence along line of lot #8 S. 76.30 W. 210 feet to point corner lot #3; thence with line of lot #3 N. 13.30 W. 12.60 feet to the beginning corner and containing 6 acres, more or less, being the same lot of land conveyed to P.
