 Whereas, I, the said J. Will Davis, on or about the 20th day of June, 1936, exhibited my Complaint in the Court of Common Pleas for Laurens County, against Myrtle McDaniel, Mary Downie McDaniel, and Charles McDaniel, demanding Judgment in relation to the premises hereinafter described, and

Whereas, said cause being at issue came on to be heard on the 3rd day of July, 1936 and resulted in a decree of said Court whereby I was directed to convey to the said Myrtle McDaniel, Mary Downie McDaniel, and Charles McDaniel, the premises hereinafter described, upon the said Myrtle McDaniel, as Guardian Ad Litem for her children Mary Downie McDaniel and Charles McDaniel, and as Special Master, executing and delivering to me a deed conveying to me Fifty (50) acres of land in Laurens County, more particularly described in the Complaint, and same has been done.

All that lot, piece or parcel of land, with improvements thereon, lying, being and situate near the City of Greenville, in Greenville Township, in the County of Greenville, in the State of South Carolina, more particularly described as follows:

Composed of tract No. 3, together with an adjoining strip of eleven and one half feet wide from eastern side of tract #4; located on the Cedar Lane Road according to a plat made by R. E. Dalton, Jan. 1929, recorded in plat book 2, page 200, said lot having a frontage of 6½ feet on Cedar Lane Road and more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at an iron pin on Cedar Lane corner Lot #2 thence N. (0° 35' E. 209.5' to an iron pin on J. B. Wall's line, thence N. 79-50 W. 6½ feet to iron pin; thence S. 9-33 W. 209.6' to iron pin on Cedar Lane Road; thence S. 79-39 E. 61 and ½ feet to the beginning corner.

The same being more particularly described in deed from J. B. Babbitt to B.S. Childress, given on the 12th of July, 1922, recorded in office of R.M.C. for Greenville County, in Vol. 58, page 567, and the same having been subsequently conveyed to me, the Plaintiff herein.

Also, three lots in the Town of Home Path, in the County of Anderson, in the State of South Carolina, known as lots Nos. 22 and 23, of sub-division of L. O. Harper property, which was sold at auction by Cleveland and Williams in May 1910. Each of said lots being fifty ft. in width and one hundred seventy feet in depth, and being lots which were conveyed by Cleveland and Williams to J. L. Raynham, on South side of Cleveland Street, by deed Recorded in Deed Book N. 4 at page 627.

Also, lot No. 24 containing 958 square yards, more or less, conveyed by Cleveland and Williams to James L. Raynham in deed hereinbefore described, and being more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at an iron XM on the South side of Shirley Street, and on the East side of Cleveland Street; thence with Shirley Street South 70 East 170 feet to iron XM; thence South 21-48 West 51.1 ft. to an iron XM; bounded by lot No. 25; thence North 69-50 West 170 ft. to a corner on East side of Cleveland Street, bounded by lot No. 25; thence along Cleveland Street North 21-48 East 50.8 feet to the beginning.

The lots herein conveyed are conveyed subject to a mortgage over the lot near the City of Greenville, in favor of Home Owners' Loan Corporation, in the original sum of \$834.75 the indebtedness represented by the note secured by said mortgage is assumed, and agreed to be paid by the grantee herein.
