In the State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of One (\$1.00) Dollars and love and affection,

to us in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by

Joseph Carlton Bates

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold, and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said Joseph Carlton Bates, his heirs and assigns:

All that certain piece, parcel or tract of land in Greenville County, State of South Carolina situated in Cleveland Township, being known and designated as Tract No. 2 of property of Mrs. Joe Bates, as shown on plat of same made by J. Coke Smith, September 18th, October 6th, 1936, said tract containing 225 acres, more or less, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

Beginning at a sycamore tree on the bank of South Saluda River at the intersection of said river with old river run and running thence along said old river run 9.49 chs to a branch; thence along said branch to the line crossing a road to Greenville, 6.20 chs. to a point; thence N. 8.00 W. 24.92 chs. to a hickory-corner of property now or formerly belonging to Saluda Land & Timber Company; thence along said Saluda Land & Timber Company property 7.7-3.5-7.88 chs. to a stone; thence S. 15°-15' E. 53.54 chs. to a stone-corner of black land; thence S. 69.00 W. 31.70 chs. to a point; thence still with said black land, S. 20-30° 42.40 chs. to a stone-corner of property now or formerly belonging to A. K. Burgess; thence S. 72-80° W. 26.93 chs. to a stone; thence S. 18-00 E. crossing a road to Greenville, 29 chs. to a point in old river run, near a W. D.; thence along old river run to a sycamore tree on the bank of South Saluda River, the point of beginning.

An easement for ingress and egress is hereby given to Joseph Carlton Bates and his children only so long as they own title to go across the property known as Tract No. 1 on said survey, to a spring just across the line between Tract No. 1 and Tract No. 2 for the purpose of obtaining water. This easement is for the benefit of Joseph Carlton Bates and his children only so long as they shall own Tract No. 2, and shall not run with the land but shall be extinguished upon the sale of the property by them to other parties.

TOGETHER with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said Premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining,
 TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular, the said premises before mentioned, unto the said,

Joseph Carlton Bates, his heirs and assigns, forever.

heirs, executors and administrators, to warrant and forever defend, all and singular, the said premises unto the said,

ourselves, our heirs and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same, or any part thereof,
