

Whereas, Lawrence C. Ashmore was adjudged bankrupt on July 9, 1934, by the proceedings instituted in the U. S. District Court for the Western District of South Carolina, and thereafter received his complete discharge; and whereas, in said proceedings, upon petition of said bankrupt, a homestead exemption in real estate was allowed to said Lawrence C. Ashmore, subject to the mortgage encumbrance thereon, as is more fully shown by order filed in the U. S. Office of the Register in Greenville recorded in the P. M. Office for Greenville County in Deed Book 182 at page 277, and wherein it is recited that the grantee herein, is the owner of the mortgage herein referred to which covers a portion of the property set off by said bankrupt as his homestead and has agreed to take title thereto subject to the mortgage thereon, thereby discharging the said Lawrence C. Ashmore from any further liability or account, to said trustee and mortgagee.

We do hereby certify that we have bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said George Ashmore, all right, title, interest or right in land in Greenville County, State of South Carolina, now or heretofore known as "Oakleaf Park," a tract of which is recorded in the P. M. C. Office for said County, in "Deed Book" L at page 114 and 115 and being designated in said plat as Lot No. 134, for a more complete description of said lot, said plat is hereby referred to.

It is understood that the above described property is subject to a mortgage recorded in the P. M. C. Office for Greenville County in "Mortgages Volume 210" at page 40, said mortgage being owned by the grantee herein but same is to remain open and continue as a lien on said property.

Elizabeth F. Ashmore, the wife of L. C. Ashmore, has joined in the execution of this deed for the purpose of conveying any and all interest which she may have in said land from L. C. Ashmore as his homestead in the proceedings above referred to.

TOGETHER with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said Premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining, TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular, the said premises before mentioned, unto the said George Ashmore,

his heirs and assigns, forever.

AND we, the undersigned, do hereby bind

heirs, executors and administrators, to warrant and forever defend, all and singular, the said premises unto the said George Ashmore,

his heirs and assigns, against

our heirs, and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same, or any part thereof.
