Place and Company and being more particularly described in meters and bounds in said contract which is recorded in the R. M. C. office for Greenville County in Vol. 104 at page 1376.

TOGETHER with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said Premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining, and all the estate, right, title, claim and interest whatsoever of the parties to the cause aforesaid, and of each of them in and to the same, and of all other persons right-fully claiming from, under, or any of them.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular the premises before mentioned, unto the said W. M. Halland and Charles Halland and their heirs and assigns forever.
