TO ALL WHOM THESE PRESENTS SHALL COME:

I, O. Luman

Master in and for the County aforesaid SEND GREETING.

WHEREAS, American Telephone and Telegraph Company  
of South Carolina et al.

on or about the 10th day of August in the year of  
our Lord nineteen hundred and twenty-nine exhibited etc complaint in the Court  
of Common Pleas for the County aforesaid against L. A. Philpot, as Administrator of the  
Wards and Chattels of Isidore J. Phillips, deceased et al,

Demanding relief in respect of the real estate described in the complaint, and the cause being at issue, came on to be heard on the 9th  
day of September 1929, and such proceedings were had therein as resulted in a decree of the said Court, whereby it was  
ordered and directed that the said real estate hereinafter mentioned and described be conveyed by O. Luman  
Master in and for the County aforesaid to American Telephone & Telegraph Co., St. C. - 6948  
for the parties mentioned in the said decree, as by reference thereto, in the said Court, will appear: (See Judgment Roll No. ....)

NOW Therefore Know all Men by these Presents that I, O. Luman  
Master in and for the County of Greenville aforesaid, by virtue of the aforesaid decree,

HAVE GRANTED, bargained and released, and by these presents, DO GRANT, convey and release unto the said

American Telephone and Telegraph Company of South  
Carolina, its successors and assigns, their  
successors, assigns, heirs and agents,  
the right, license and authority to construct, reconstruct  
elevate and maintain lines of telephone and telegraph  
conveying in such form, wires, cables, conduits, guys,  
poles and other fixtures ready, prepared and  
the people may from time to time require, upon  
across the road or highway the capacity which the  
parties have to lay or have any interest in a strip  
of land 100 ft. wide, running 50 ft. each way from  
the center of the location of the line, the utility  
company in the vicinity across of a tract of 2.3 acres, located  
between the Pease Bridge Road and S. U. of the Dumm Lane  
Bridge Road, about 4 miles N. of the City of Greenville  
County and State aforesaid, said strip described  
as follows:

Beginning at approximately 100 ft. east of the Phillips  
house up on the North side of the Dumm Lane Bridge  
Road, thence a corner at approximately 100 ft. under ground 100  
ft. 15 ft. thence in a westerly direction from Post  
100 ft. 15 ft. corner, thence in a westerly direction  
approximately 100 ft. to the telephone department  
of the Plainfield Telephone and Telegraph  
Company of South Carolina and to which reference is hereby  
made of the record of the same.

and upon, along and in under the roads, streets  
or highways adjoining the said property, with the right  
to run from time to time any lines along said lines as  
and to keep the wires and cables cleared at least  
thirty six inches and the right to permit the attachment  
or add or carry in conduct wires and cables of any  
other company and with the further right to cut  
down and to keep cut down all trees and under  
growth within 50 feet of said line.

The Grantor for himself, his heirs, executors, administrators  
and assigns hereby covenants that no wires line shall  
be erected or permitted on said property which in the  
judgment of the grantee, its successors and assigns,  
will interfere with its service or endanger its lines  
and that no inflammable structure will be erected  
or permitted on said property within 50 feet of said  
line. Said sum being received in full payment for  
the rights herein granted.

TOGETHER with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said Premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining,  
and all the estate, right, title, claim and interest whatsoever of the parties to the cause aforesaid, and of each of them in and to the same, and of all other persons right-  
fully claiming from, under, or any of them.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD all and singular the premises before mentioned, unto the said  
American Telephone and Telegraph Company, its successors  
and assigns forever.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I, the said Master in and for the County aforesaid, under and by virtue of the aforesaid Decree, have hereunto set my hand and
