and others, and containing 12.1 acres, more or less, according
to survey and plat by H. S. Brockman, Surveyor."

TOGETHER with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said Premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining,
and all the estate, right, title, claim and interest whatsoever of the parties to the cause aforesaid, and of each of them in and to the same, and of all other persons right-
fully claiming from, under, or any of them.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular the premises before mentioned, unto the said

P. D. Copeland, his heirs and assigns forever.
